LAST EVENTS

Second annual MOTTLES survey

Every year, MOTTLES surveyor teams carry out the assessment of tree responses to ozone pollution at the forest sites of our network with the help of local site managers.

Assessments of crown conditions (i.e. discoloration, defoliation) and of visible foliar ozone-induced injury were carried out at 17 forest plots during summer 2018 (August-September). Data will be then related with the ozone metrics calculated on the basis of direct measurements at those sites.

MOTTLES organized a session addressed to stakeholders ("Bridging science and decision-making for monitoring ozone harm to forests"). Download this file for more info or visit conference website




IV CONGRESSO NAZIONALE DI SELVICOLTURA
